How our programs are set up...

The 2018 APLD Bay Area board is excited about the programs we're offering this year. Building on the model we've established for learning from and with our colleagues and other leading practitioners in landscape design. We set a goal to have at least two programs each month (one in the East Bay and one on the Peninsula – the areas where most of our members are) and to make them compelling enough that all of our members will be willing to travel a bit to attend these programs. In order to manage all these events, we will require advance online registration for all 2018 programs.

The programs are divided into three basic categories:

Speaker Series

Experts share their knowledge on a particular topic in a lecture format with general District announcements before and networking opportunities before and after.

Online registration required.

Most lectures in this series = 1.5 APLD CEUs, but please always check the details on the individual online registration pages.

Designer Forum Series

Landscape professionals gather in small groups to share ideas and conduct panel and roundtable discussions about a particular topic. Each discussion is moderated by a board member and many will have expert "special guests" in attendance.

Space is very limited and online registration required for all.

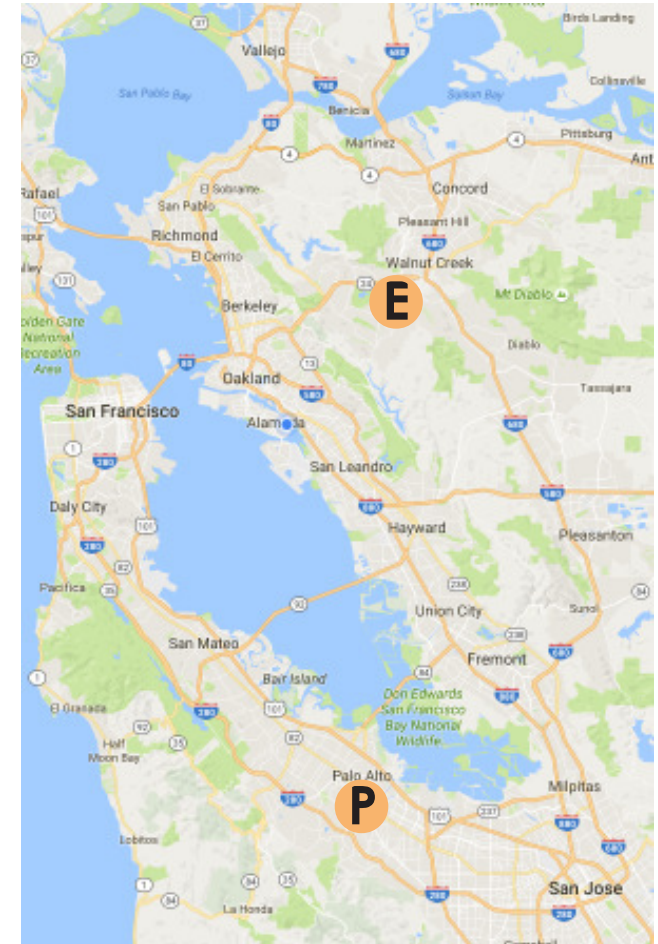
